FCI breeds 3 - nomenclature

AIREDALE TERRIER

Measures	Ideal
Height at the withers	Males 58 - 61cm, females 56 - 59cm
Weight	

Standards	FCI – 007
Coat	Hard, dense and wiry, not so long as to appear ragged.
Colour	Body saddle black or grizzle as is top of the neck and top surface of tail. All other parts tan.



Country of origin: GREAT BRITAIN

Largest of the Terriers, a muscular, active, fairly cobby dog, without suspicion of legginess or undue length of body.

Keen of expression, quick of movement, on the tiptoe of expectation at any movement.

Character denoted and shown by expression of eyes, and by carriage of ears and erect tail.

Outgoing and confident, friendly, courageous, and intelligent. Alert at all times, not aggressive but fearless.

AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE TERRIER

Measures	Ideal
Height at the withers	Male 64-48cm, female 43-46cm
Weight	

Standards	FCI – 286
Coat	Short, close, stiff to the touch, glossy.
Colour	Any colour, solid, particolour, or patched is permissible; but more than 80% white



Country of origin: U.S.A.

The Staffordshire Terrier should give the impression of great strength for his size; a well put together dog, muscular, but agile and graceful, keenly alive to his surroundings. He should be stocky, not long-legged or racy in outline. His courage is proverbial.

Coat	Must be flat, fine and glossy and of a silky texture.
Colour	All shades of blue and tan are acceptable, the richer these colours and more clearly defined the better.

The dog is compact, moderately low set, of medium length with a refined structure but of sufficient substance to suggest the ability to hunt and kill domestic rodents. The parted, straight silky hair presents a well-groomed appearance.

It should display Terrier characteristics, embodying keen alertness, activity and soundness. A courageous and dignified Toyterrier, that is second to none as a companion.

A sturdy low-set dog, rather long in proportion to height with strong Terrier character, alertness, activity and soundness.

Essentially a working terrier, but its loyalty and even disposition make it equally suitable as a companion dog.

Colour	For white, pure white coat. For coloured, colour predominates; Black brindle, red, fawn and tricolour.

Irrespective of size dogs should look masculine and bitches feminine.

Short legged, long haired, well made and well muscled Terrier with smallish drop ears, of a rectangular format.

Balanced, non-aggressive, pleasant and cheerful companion, easy to train; somewhat reserved towards strangers; of calm and kind disposition.

Distinctive head with beautiful silky covering, with large, wise intelligent eyes offsetting long, low weaselly body. Short, strong legs; weatherproof coat.

Game, workmanlike Terrier. Independent, highly intelligent, determined, persistent, sensitive, affectionate and dignified.

ENGLISH TOY TERRIER BLACK (B&T)

Measures	Ideal
Height at the withers	Between 25 and 30 cm
Weight	Between 2,7 and 3,6 kg

Standards	FCI – 013
Coat	Thick, close and glossy. A density of short hair required.
Colour	Black and tan. The black ebony, the tan likened to a new chestnut deeply rich.

Well balanced, elegant and compact, sleek and cleanly built. Head and legs proportionate thus producing the correct balance.

Toy with Terrier characteristics. Alert, remembering that historically he could acquit himself satisfactorily in the rat pit. Never unduly nervous.

Coat	Straight, flat, smooth, hard, dense and abundant.
Colour	White should predominate, all white, white with tan, black and tan or black markings.

Active and lively, bone and strength in small compass, never cloddy or coarse. Neither leggy nor too short in the leg, standing like a well made, short-backed hunter, covering a lot of ground.

Colour	White predominates with black, black and tan or tan markings.

A smallish, generally black and tan, compact, well proportioned working hunting dog.

Courageous and hard, takes pleasure in work, enduring, vital, full of temperament, reliable, sociable and trainable, neither shy nor aggressive.
